

After the Root Canal

- 1. After the appointment your jaw may be sore because you were open for a long time.
- 2. The injection sites may also be sore.
- 3. The tooth itself can remain sensitive for a few days. This soreness will slowly go away. A mild analgesic (aspirin, Tylenol, or Advil) may be taken to ease the discomfort.
- 4. If swelling occurs, please call our office immediately.
- 5. If a temporary filling material has been placed in the tooth, small pieces may be lost. This is not a major concern. If larger pieces are lost, please call the office.
- 6. If you have any questions or problems, please call our office.
